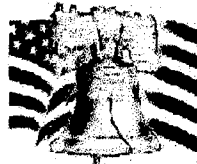

Equipment that is too outdated or broken can and should be recycled instead of dumped--call SWACO (Franklin County solid waste authority). Usable furniture (and other basic household necessities) in fair condition would be welcomed by Material Assistance Providers (these folks will pass it on FREE to formerly homeless and otherwise needy folks). Games and good sports equipment can go to the kidney foundation, VOA, shelters. Most of these organizations offer free pick-up. Save landfill space, do a good turn, and get a tax deduction--all it takes is a few phone calls!

Also, please remember to not put your trash cans on the sidewalk. For safety reasons and the convenience of walkers, please place your cans in the grass or on your driveway so the sidewalk stays clear.
