LUMINARY SET UP AND THANKS

I want to thank each of the 24 volunteers, including 8 youth, who assembled 899 luminary kits for the 838 homes in our neighborhood on Saturday, December 3. Although it was raining heavily earlier in the morning, by 10:00 AM when we started kit assembly, the rain had completely stopped and the weather was comfortable for our outside volunteers.

All but six Trustees were able to pick up their completed bundles of kits before 1:00 PM, and so volunteers delivered their bundles to them, which included one large bundle for which volunteer Al Smyth delivered the kits to all homes in this District due to Trustee illness. And thus my special appreciation to Al, who has been "backstopping" the kit assembly event with multiple Trustee bundle deliveries each year since 2014!

And last, but not least, I thank our Trustees who deliver the luminary kits to each home in their District (plus delivering the Couriers and CHCA membership packets, and many of whom have additional roles within the CHCA).

Colonial Hills was blessed with great weather for our Neighborhood Luminary Display, which includes the luminaries ringing Selby Park, on Sunday, December 11, from 7:00 to 9:00 PM. As I drove the streets in the Hills that evening, I estimated that we had approximately 95% overall participation, with long expanses of continuous displays on Indianola and the Selbys, and some streets such as Meadoway and Park Overlook with virtually 100% participation!

In fact, even with driving very slowly, windows rolled down and flashers on, I felt as if my vehicle was an intruder on the streets which, along with the sidewalks, were filled with folks, including strollers and pets, enjoying the great weather and our amazing holiday decorations. And of course, I had to park by the curb for about five minutes, to become part of the ongoing crowd of children (and adults) marveling at the awesome display at a certain home.







And finally, I must thank every neighbor who set up their luminaries in front of their residence, and those who decorate their homes for the season, to make our Colonial Hills holiday celebration uniquely jolly.

Colonial Hills Civic Association Scholarship Application

The following are eligibility requirements and conditions for the Colonial Hills Civic Association Scholarship:

- 1) The applicant must be a current resident of Colonial Hills, Worthington, Ohio and a graduating high school senior during the current year or someone pursuing continuing education.
- 2) The Scholarship may be used for all types of educational programs beyond high school (e.g., college, vocational, technical, and business institutes).
- 3) The Scholarship must be used within one (1) calendar year of the award and will be made available in a lump sum payment upon proof of enrollment in an academic or vocational program and proof of residency in Colonial Hills, Worthington, Ohio.
- 4) The applicant must complete this form for consideration. Final selection will be the sole decision of the Colonial Hills Civic Association. All information will be kept confidential except essay question response(s).
- 5) The completed application must be received by APRIL 6th, and can be submitted by any of the following methods. Mail entries must be postmarked by April 3rd and sent to CHCA, PO Box 676, Worthington, OH 43085. You may also bring your application to a Civic Association meeting, or deliver it to the current CHCA Secretary (by April 6).
 Optionally, you may also submit by e-mail as follows: Attach your completed application to an e-mail sent to CHCA.Worthington@gmail.com; your e-mail must have a timestamp before midnight April 6th. Although the CHCA will reply to confirm receipt of your application via e-mail, please save your sent e-mail until you receive CHCA confirmation that we received it.
- 6) The application must be signed by the student and parent/guardian(s). For an e-mail submission: By PDF, please make sure your attached scanned PDF has the signature lines completed. Or with an attached Word document, please scan in either PDF or JPEG photo format the page with signature lines, and then also attach this scanned or photographed page, in addition to attaching your Word document.

NOMINATE A NEIGHBOR - MEET JIM LOEFFLER

The song "Seasons of Love" from Rent asks the question how do you measure a life? If we were measuring in time, Jim Loeffler has to be one of the oldest neighbors in Colonial Hills, as he will turn 92 this year. If you measure in music, he could be measured by his basement which is stocked with over 12,000 LP's and 9,000+ 78's, not to mention the hundreds of CD's and cassettes. If it is a story, well, next time you are walking along Indianola and see a kind older man sitting on his porch, stop on by and ask and you won't be disappointed.

Mr. Loeffler moved into Colonial Hills in 1960, the third owner of the house, and planted roots that have yet to be pulled out. He and his late wife Lucille raised two sons in the house that, as many houses in the neighborhood have been, has been modified over the years. A jack of all trades and far more capable than most, Jim has opened walls, moved doors, all while maintaining a certain aesthetic that is unique to his artistic vision. The walls are all decorated with unique art pieces he has collected or painted during his long life.



A lifelong love of music was started by his father, an amateur musician. He came from a long line of craftsmen but never thought he had the talent but during a 3 years stint in Europe, serving in the Air Force from 1950-54, he picked up bass to play in a band with some fellow servicemen. A passion was born and though he never learned to read music, it didn't stop him from playing for the past 70 years.

His love of music is evident from the moment that you walk in the door. From the upright bass that was handmade, to the ukulele and guitar from the 20's, to the shelves dedicated to jazz greats Duke Ellington, Louis Armstrong and Jack Teagarten, it is apparent that Jim's love of music far exceeds the ordinary bystander. The crank Starr Phonograph in the corner, working jukeboxes in the add-on family room, and autographs and paintings on the wall speak to a deep appreciation of the classics. Want to catch Mr. Loeffler in action? In the spring through fall months, he still plays with the Bexley Jam Band on Thursday evenings at Johnson's Ice Cream in Bexley.

Wait, you might ask, isn't he 91? He still has a busier social calendar than most people half his age... well, really busier than most people, period. Monday's is Vaughn Wiester's Famous Jazz Orchestra at the Clintonville Women's Club, Friday's is the Rick Brunetto Big Band at the Valley Dale Ballroom, euchre is a couple nights a week. You could say age is just a number, but his body has slowed down a little. He no longer runs the multiple businesses he once started and his painting and art has slowed to focus on just photography these days. With everything he has experienced, he says with thankfulness, that he has no regrets, just fond memories.
